### WHAT YOU NEED TO QUALIFY

- > Must be 21+ years of age
- > Good driving record (DMV K-4 printout)
- > Must be able to read, write, speak and understand English, at intermediate level
- > California Class C driver's license

### WHAT TO EXPECT IF YOU ARE A QUALIFIED CANDIDATE

1. Assistance with application from the PACE Downtown/ Pico Union WorkSource Center (may include an ESL assessment); interviews; candidate test; background check	English
2. Integrated Education and Training, Support with English through Evans Community Adult School (LAUSD)	English
3. Metro training	English, with Spanish support
4. Metro final test, DMV test	English
5. Start driving!
