### **PREREQUISITES:**

- ✓ High School Diploma or GED/HiSET
- ✓ Reading Level 9.0
- ✓ Math Level 8.0
- ✓ 18 Years of Age

This one-semester course is designed to prepare students for employment in a pharmacy setting and to sit for the PTCB national certification exam. This competency-based class consists of theory and hands-on training in a pharmacy.

At the successful completion of this course, students will receive a certificate of completion and are qualified to be licensed with the California State Board as a Pharmacy Technician; essential for seeking employment.

The competencies in this course are aligned with the California High School Academic Content Standards and the California Career Technical Education Model Curriculum Standards.

**U.S. Department of Labor Job Outlook:** Employment of pharmacy technicians is projected to grow 9 percent from 2014 to 2024, faster than the average for all occupations. Several factors will lead to increased demand for prescription medications.
