- Powers of arrest
- Weapons of mass destruction and terrorism
- Evacuation procedures
- Access and crowd control, Parking/traffic control
- Employability skills
- Public relations
- Observation and documentation
- Communication protocols
- Liability/legal aspects
- Officer safety
- Courtroom demeanor
- Fire safety
